### **What will I be doing?**

#### **Role 1 – Bar (over 18s only)**

Working on either the Cask Ale & Cider bar; Lager, Keg Bottled Beer or Gin and Wine bar. Previous bar experience desirable, but not essential as full training will be given.

#### ***Duties could include –***

- Serving beer/cider/wine
- Stock replenishment
- Keeping bar area clean and tidy
- Chatting with customers
- Setting up bar for the day ensuring everything is correctly labelled, stocked and displayed
- Separating bottles for recycling
- Advising bar manager when beer/cider is no longer available

**Role 2 – General Steward Working in various non-bar roles around the festival.**

***Duties could include –***

- Ensuring food hall/beer hall is litter free and tidy
- Collecting & Washing glasses/plates
- Selling tickets, tokens, programmes and glasses
- Cloakroom duties
- Emptying bins in beer hall
- Admission management –keeping an eye on how many people are in the festival
- General presence in beer hall to answer questions and ensure everyone acting appropriately.
- Setting up and taking down (bar, tables and entrance)
